Day 1 - Friday 29 Jan, 2027- Calgary / Buenos Aires: Depart Canada

Overnight flight:

Day 2 - Saturday 30 Jan, 2027 - Buenos Aires - D

Arrive in Buenos Aires / meet with your English speaking guide

09.20 h - Arrival in Buenos Aires city and transfer to the hotel.

15.00 h - check in

Welcome dinner—Traditional Argentinean BBQ

Overnight in Buenos Aires.

Day 3: Sunday 31st, 2027: Buenos Aires - BLD

Morning City Tour of Argentina - Free time at La Boca Quarter, shop and watch Tango on the street, bars etc. .

Buenos Aires is the capital of Argentina and is where most cultural, political and economic activities take place. It is a charming city with a strong influence from the most important cities of Europe. Beautiful walks, avenues and parks, monumental buildings, typical restaurant, pavement cafes, churches and museums in 46 different regions – each with its own personality. The north offers an elegant resemblance of Paris, with the many avenue housing the most unforgettable coffee houses. In the shady streets of Belgrano one can taste the charm of the distinguished London suburbs and Naples seems to be present in the bustling and coloured La Boca Quarter.

Lunch in Puerto Madero.

Continue to the San Telmo street market and free afternoon in Buenos Aires city centre

Overnight: Buenos Aires

Day 4: Monday, Feb 1st, 2027: Buenos Aires - BL

Morning presentation about Agriculture in Argentina - insights into the grain and cattle production in a meeting room of the hotel.

Departure to Magdalena for visit to a **Wagyu and Angus stud. Angus Breeding:** Built on a foundation of more than 30 years of experience breeding top-tier black and red Aberdeen Angus cattle. **Wagyu Breeding:** They are one of the pioneer Wagyu breeders in the country. **Lunch Asado BBQ at the farm.**

Return to Buenos Aires.

Overnight: Buenos Aires



Day 5: Tuesday Feb 2nd, 2027: Buenos Aires BLD

Visit to Liniers Livestock Market.

In the morning we will visit Liniers Livestock Market – One of the largest Cattle Market in the World. The market sells 140,000 head, they have 55 agents operating and 550 buyers. The number of online users has grown over the last 3 years; currently they have 35,000 registered users.

Visit LA PASTORIZA – hosted by Ricardo Orazi

LA PASTORIZA runs 3000 commercial cows, 1000 pure controlled cows, 150 pedigree cows. They breed with bulls, I.A. and embryo transfers. PASTORIZA has an annual auction which takes place in July, they sell 120 bulls, black and red Angus between the ages of 20 to 24 months with an average weight of 650 kilos. They also sell 500 head of cows in different categories based on age, so their customers have different options based on their needs. www.anguspastoriza.com.ar

Lunch on the farm & continue to Tandil. Group Dinner this evening.

Overnight: Tandil

Day 6: Wednesday Feb 3rd, 2027 BL

Tandil city is south eastern Buenos Aires provincia (province), eastern Argentina. It is situated within the Pampas at the northern end of the Tandil Mountains, about 305 km south of Buenos Aires city. Pretty Tandil is a leafy, walkable, endearing city with world-class delis, public orange trees, wonderful period architecture, upstart craft breweries and nearby trails to explore.

Morning visit to **grain and cattle operation (mixed farm)**

Afternoon visit to a **Salami and Cheese factory.**

Shopping at a Gaucho, traditional silver and leather store.

Free evening - dinner on your own and free time to explore Tandil

Overnight : Tandil

Day 7: Thursday Feb 4th, 2027 Tandil to Buenos Aires BLD

Morning visit to a forage cropping and high tech dairy farm.

Group lunch

Visit Cabaña Santa Ana-(Criollos Horse Ranch)

Morning Visit a Horse Ranch where you will find the “criollo”, the king of the pampas.

The criollo (Argentinean Horse) is a strong and rustic horse descended from Spanish horses and naturally adapted to the Pampas. The breed, known for its hardiness and stamina, is most popular as a working horse.

Continue onto Buenos Aires

Overnight: Buenos Aires



Day 8: Friday, Feb 5th, 2027: Buenos Aires to Iguazu Falls - BD

Transfer to the airport for flight to Iguazú.

11.15 h - Flight departure.

13.10 h - Arrival in Puerto Iguazú and transfer to the hotel for a free afternoon to enjoy the swimming pool.

Late afternoon a boat Cruise on the Paraná and Iguazú rivers: Enjoy a boat cruise to navigate the Paraná and Iguazú rivers. Enjoy the landscape with drinks and live music on board.

Then continue to the hotel for dinner.

Overnight: Iguazu Falls

Day 9: Saturday, Feb 6th, 2027: Iguazu Falls - BD

Full day excursion at falls and walk jungle

The semi-circular waterfall at the heart of this site is some 80 m high and 2,700 m in diameter and is situated on a basaltic line spanning the border between Argentina and Brazil. Made up of many cascades producing vast sprays of water, it is one of the most spectacular waterfalls in the world. The surrounding subtropical rainforest has over 2,000 species of vascular plants and is home to the typical wildlife of the region: tapirs, giant anteaters, howler monkeys, ocelots, jaguars and caymans.

Overnight Iguazu Falls

Day 10: Sunday Feb 7th, 2027: Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay BL

Transfer to the airport for flight to Buenos Aires.

Departure from IGR at 10.15 h / Arrival in AEP 12.15 h, and transfer to the ferry station.

Cross the Río de La Plata by ferry boat to Colonia del Sacramento (Uruguay)

Colonia del Sacramento offers a glimpse into the very roots of Uruguay's history. Founded in 1680 by the Portuguese, who sought to establish their presence along the Río de la Plata, the city became a source of conflict with Spain, which eventually took control after numerous disputes. Located directly across from Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina, Colonia's historic quarter has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Its architecture is a fusion of Spanish, Portuguese, and post-colonial styles. One of the most iconic and picturesque streets is "Calle de los Suspiros" (Street of Sighs). It is a peaceful gem blending beauty, legacy, and tranquility.

On this day, we will enjoy a guided tour through the city and its historic center, exploring the colonial lifestyle and atmosphere of a bygone era

Rest of the afternoon free to discover Colonia.

Overnight: Colonia del Sacrament



Day 11 - Monday Feb 8th, 2027 - Colonia del Sacramento BL

Visit to a Cattle Farm: The ranch works with Hereford and Aberdeen Angus (black and red) breeds. There are 4,000 head of beef cattle—80% Hereford and 20% Aberdeen Angus. Currently, the annual sales of the establishment total 300 tons of meat and between 100 to 120 breeding bulls from both breeds.

Visit to a winery for a technical visit & tasting

Uruguay, with its undulating landscapes and temperate climate, offers a unique winemaking experience that blends tradition, innovation, and a profound respect for the land. Throughout the country, soils range from Brunosols, rich in organic matter and ideal for producing intense reds, to Vertisols, dark and clay-rich, which retain water well and support the slow, balanced ripening of grapes.

In regions such as Canelones, Maldonado, and Colonia, vineyards stretch across gentle hills with well-drained soils, where the Tannat grape — the national emblem — reaches its fullest expression. This varietal, originally from south-western France, has adapted beautifully to the Urugayan terroir, giving rise to robust wines with firm tannins and excellent aging potential.

Overnight: Colonia del Sacramento.

Day 12 - Tuesday Feb 9th, 2027- Colonia del Sacramento BLD

Morning farm visit: mix farm, grain + cattle. Meeting with the farmer

In this region, producers are generally mixed — they grow grains alongside livestock. We will visit a mixed producer who owns his own land and also leases other parcels to grow soybeans, wheat, and corn, while also rotating with live-stock production, using the Aberdeen-Angus breed.

Afternoon farm visit: The farm operates a full-cycle livestock system including cow-calf operation, backgrounding and feedlot fattening. The cow-calf operation phase is carried out on natural pastureland, working with a herd of Aberdeen Angus mothers, which they maintain as the genetic base for their commercial calf production.

Overnight: Colonia del Sacramento.

Day 13 - Wednesday 10th Feb, 2027 - Colonia del Sacramento / Buenos Aires BD

Free morning and cross the Río de La Plata by ferry boat.

Arrive in Buenos Aires and transfer to the hotel.

Farewell dinner with Tango Show.



Day 14 - Thursday 11th Feb, 2027 - Buenos Aires / Calgary (B,D)

Late morning check out at the hotel.

Free time in the downtown area for shopping

Transfer to Tigre for lunch and a navigation in the Delta of Tigre.

First we will navigate through the tranquil streams of the Tigre Delta, surrounded by weekend houses, colorful docks and the daily life of the islanders. We`ll experience authentic island life as we explore narrow canals and discover what it`s like to live among the water and the vegetation. Then we`ll head into UNESCO protected areas, where the landscape becomes wilder and quieter. Join this adventure to watch birds in their natural habitat, swim in streams and experience the peace of these pristine environments. There will also be time for lunch in one of the island bars built at altitude, where the local charm and simple yet tasty gastronomy combine with unique views.

End of afternoon dinner and transfer to the international airport for flight back home.
